Day 1 Fly to Montreal

Day 6 1000 Islands / To Toronto (B)

After breakfast enjoy the scenery as you travel to the 1000 Islands area which is made up of 1864 islands straddling the US-Canadian border. Board your 1000 Islands Cruise to travel amongst some of the large, small, and tiny islands. Later travel to Toronto, Canada's largest city. Check into your hotel and enjoy the evening at leisure.

Day 3 Rail to Quebec City (BD)

This morning board VIA Rail Canada for the scenic and relaxing train ride to the "Paris of North America," Quebec City. Carved into the bluffs overlooking the St. Lawrence River, Quebec City is the provincial capital and probably the best preserved city in North America. Dinner is included this evening at a popular local restaurant.

Day 7 Toronto / To Niagara (B)

This morning enjoy a Toronto City Tour featuring the modern downtown area, Yorkville, and the Provincial Parliament. Toronto is a dynamic metropolis with a core of soaring skyscrapers, all dwarfed by the iconic, free-standing CN Tower. Later visit Niagara-on-the-Lake, a charming Canadian town. Then travel to Niagara Falls and check into your hotel for two nights on the Canadian side of the Falls.

Day 4 Quebec City (B)

Today enjoy a Quebec City Tour introducing you to Old & New Quebec, North America's only walled city. The tour features the Plains of Abraham, the famous Le Chateau Frontenac, and The Citadel. This afternoon visit the Albert Gilles Copper Museum to discover his creations from copper ore to works of art. Discover the mysterious atmosphere of a copper mine, and see copper bearing rocks. Later visit the historic Montmorency Falls, the highest falls in Eastern Canada—98 feet higher than Niagara Falls & one of the most popular attractions in the region.

Day 8 Niagara Falls (BD)

Today enjoy a Niagara Falls City Tour featuring the Floral Clock (the largest in the world) and the Horticultural Center. Later experience the legendary Niagara Falls Boat Tour for a breathtaking up close encounter with the awe-inspiring thundering falls. Tonight enjoy a Farewell Dinner at the world-famous Skylon Tower which combines an exhilarating 52 second ride with the awe of seeing Niagara from 775 feet high.

Day 5 Ottawa (B)

Today travel along the banks of the St. Lawrence River, a route used by early French explorers

II. AFC "Any Reason" Cancellation Waiver (ARCW) - Reimburses 75% of the cancellation fees in the form of a future travel credit certificate (FTCC) valid for 1 year, if you cancel more than 48 hours prior to scheduled departure for any reason not eligible for cash refund under the TCW (Part A - I). FTCC is non-transferable, may not be redeemed for cash and does not include any credit for the Trip Cancellation Waiver Fee. **The Trip Cancellation Waiver Fee must be paid for with Initial Deposit and is refundable until 180 days prior to departure.** The Trip Cancellation Waiver does not cover any single supplement charges due to an individual's traveling companion canceling prior to departure. The Trip Cancellation Waiver is non-transferable and valid for each applicant only. The Trip Cancellation Waiver does not cover any services such as airline tickets not purchased through AFC. Cancellations, Refunds & Inquiries under Part A will be handled by AFC. Certain Exclusions and Restrictions apply.
